C. Guidelines for writing a good abstract.

#### 1. Topic & Content

The topic of the essay is clearly relevant to the annual theme.

The essay asks a clear theoretical or empirical question.

The author presents a hypothesis as his/her argument to the proposed issue or question.

#### 2. Theory

The essay engages with theoretical arguments closely related to the proposed topic and question.

#### 3. Methodology

The essay will employ a particular method to present empirical evidence for the author's argument.

#### 4. Writing

The abstract has a logical structure and is well-written.

The abstract is within the word limit.

**Your abstract should not exceed 400 words. (8 or 9 sentences, 1 paragraph)**

※ Abstract submission will be disqualified if it is not on the topic.
